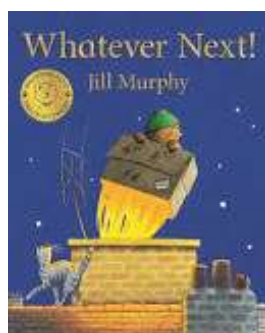
Outdoor learning: can you make a telescope and/or binoculars, then test them out?
