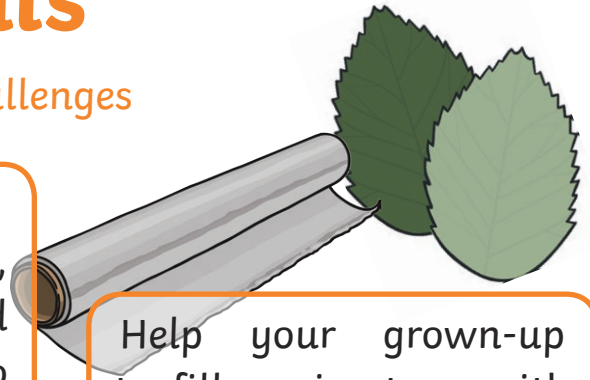


Materials

Home Learning Challenges

Collect together a selection of different objects from your home with a grown-up, such as cotton wool, tin foil, a scouring pad and place them in a bag. Take it in turns to put your hand in the 'feely bag'; say what the object feels like and then guess which object you can feel.



Help your grown-up to fill an ice tray with water. Place it in the freezer and see what has happened to the water when you take it out of the freezer the next day. Explore what happens to the ice as you hold it in your hands!



Go for a walk in the woods with a grown-up and collect some natural materials, such as leaves, twigs, and pine cones. When you get home, you could paint or draw a picture of the different natural materials you have found.



When you are in the bath, ask your grown-up to place different objects in the bath, such as rubber ducks and sponges. Count how many of the objects sink to the bottom and how many of the objects float on the top of the water.
