Tuesday

Activity 1: Model reading the story and ask the following questions about the pictures in the book.

- What do you think this is used for? Do our weighing scales look like that?



- Why do you think they wash with a bowl and a jug?

Wednesday

Today your child will read the book to you.

Activity 1: Your child reads the book independently.

Questions to ask your child

- 1) What is a maid?
- 2) Do you think Jim is rich? What are the clues?

Thursday

Today your child will answer questions about what they have read.

### Questions to talk about

Ask children to TTYP for each question using 'Fastest finger' (FF) or 'Have a think' (HaT).

- p.10 (FF) Who is Patch?
- p.11 (FF) Where does the maid do the washing?
- p.13 (FF) What lights up the bedroom?
- p.14 (FF) What does Jim use to have a wash?
- p.16 (HaT) Does Jim like his house?

Friday

Today your child will write answer to inference questions.

( You might want to think about clothes, toys, lights and toilets!)
