A highlight from last week...


In this school year, we have the privilege of welcoming a chess tutor into Year 4 on Wednesday afternoons.

There will be whole class chess sessions in Year 4 until Christmas, and then we will select 8-12 children who show particular interest and/or aptitude to continue receiving chess tuition.
